

2. A healthy Third Eye is a sign of perceptiveness. Someone who is comfortable with his spirituality, and is therefore aware of his motivations; motive to act derives from a spiritual understanding of one's world and the processes at work within it.

1. If hearing were the only physical sense, shapes, orientation, identity and the rest of reality would be sequences of oscillations.   - 1. Air is intellect, abstraction, concept. Air surrounds and permeates everything; everything is wrapped in of air, but the air itself is one whole entity. Sensors report gradients of temperature, touch, pressure and pain; only extremes will provoke an instinctive response, and any contact falling between the extremes is interpreted more consciously.
